



# Camas an Raoigh

- 1** A building. 5.30 x 3.0m. 1.8m highest. 273<sup>0</sup>. There is a doorway to the south, 189<sup>0</sup>, a window, and one corner fire-place. 73379/83251. (17/4/2009).



- 2** A building. 8.04 x 3.20m. 12<sup>0</sup>. There is a doorway to 292<sup>0</sup> and it has two top stones. There is a window-place on the short wall and a closed up window to 292<sup>0</sup>. There is a gap of 0.7m to 3. 73347/83246. (17/4/2009).
- 3** A building close to 2. 4.75 x 2.35m. 299<sup>0</sup>. There is a doorway to 210<sup>0</sup> and one small square wall-hole near the east wall. There is a 1.3m gap to the wall of 4. 73340/83250. (17/4/2009).



**The nearest buildings are 2 and 3. The building further away is site 5.**



16 There is a cairn of stones near to 15. 73199/83203. (17/4/2009).



There is a set of four concrete posts here like 17. A stone-built pathway begins from here and goes up the hill to the top. 73866/83606.




